3. Matters Arising/Chairperson's Report:

- Fundraising: The chair explained that we will raise funds through our tuck shops at various school events like the Christmas Concert, school shows, etc, along with selling raffle tickets for gift baskets. The banner would have the word 'Welcome' printed in a variety of languages and hopefully offer a friendly message when visitors enter our school lobby. The pupils proposed that they would sell lavender bags for £2 each and asked us to match the funds that they would raise through the sales. - Stirling Council 'Big Conversation' Potential Budget Cuts 2024-25: Mr Pennock explained to the group that Stirling Council is holding meetings with communities and residents called the 'Big Conversation.' The purpose of the meetings and an online survey is to address the estimated £13 million budget shortfall for 2024-25 and share with everyone the proposed cuts to cover the shortfall. The group discussed the cuts and how parents can have their say on different options. AC: Chair to Inform parents/carers of the survey and drop in sessions and encourage people to participate.
